Can I stay with my group in summer 2020 while I'm serving at the conference?

You will be housed and have meals with the other planning team members in Assembly Inn. Therefore if your group is here during one of your planning team weeks, you will not be staying with them. If you are on a planning team a different pair of youth conference weeks than your group, you would be able to attend the conference and stay with your group when they attend.

Could I be present through meetings in any other way (i.e., skyping in) in case school interferes? Your presence at the meeting is mandatory and part of your requirement as a planning team member. If selected, the covenant that you will be asked to sign says,

"I am being invited to be part of this team in part because I am available to attend the planning meeting in its entirety. I understand that failure to attend this meeting generally means that I will have to resign from the team. Exceptions may be made for family emergencies."
