

Montreat Family Campground Information and Guidelines

Thank you for camping with us. We are excited to welcome you to Montreat!

CHECK-IN: 3pm - 8pm

Before entering the campground, please register at the Assembly Inn (401 Assembly Dr / Montreat, NC 28757).

Please note there is no check-in after 8pm unless there is a prior authorization

CHECK OUT: 11am

QUIET TIME: 9pm – 8am

PLAYGROUND: Open from 9am – 9pm

THINGS TO KNOW:

- **BEARS:** Beware of bears. Keep ALL edible items (even gum and toothpaste) and coolers inside your vehicle when you leave your campsite and at night.
- **CAMPFIRES:** Build campfires in existing pits only. Do not cut live trees.
- **FIREWOOD:**
 - From Memorial Day to Labor Day, firewood is available to purchase from the campground rangers from Noon – 8pm Daily.
 - During off season, firewood can be purchased at the Front Desk (@ Assembly Inn).
- **GENERATORS:** In order to respect the environment and other campers, we do not permit generators.
- **WATER** is available from spigots along the road.
- **BATHHOUSE**
 - From Memorial Day to Labor Day, the bathhouse is closed from 1:30pm - 3pm for cleaning.
 - During the off season, there will be signage to indicate when the bathhouse is closed.
- **SHOWERS:** Please make every effort to conserve water by taking short showers.
**PLEASE ENSURE THAT THE SHOWER CURTAIN REMAINS INSIDE THE STALL WHILE SHOWERING.*
- **WASH TUB** is located behind lower bathhouse for washing dishes. Please use the provided pail and leave the area clean.
- **PETS:** Pets must remain on leash in accordance with Buncombe County Leash Law. Please be responsible and clean up after your pet.
- **GARBAGE:** Put garbage in plastic bags in dumpster, close, and latch the door.
**This should be a task performed by adults to ensure the locking occurs.*
- **RECYCLE:** Recyclable items* should be put in the green bin by the woodshed.
**cans, aluminum, paper, plastic bottles and flattened cardboard*

PLEASE:

Do not move the logs and rocks placed in the campsites. They are used to keep the gravel inside the sites.

Do not move picnic tables.

Do not smoke outside of your reserved campsite.
