

## **Interested in learning more about the Private Housing option for Montreat Conferences?**

Here is a list of things that might be helpful.

- Montreat Conference Center has an updated rental list as a service for their conferees and other visitors to the area. This is the best tool to have if you are looking for a private cottage to rent. You may either pick one up at the Assembly Inn front desk or request that one be mailed or emailed to you by contacting Polly Cameron at 828.419.9801 or at [pollyc@montreat.org](mailto:pollyc@montreat.org).
- The list is sorted by sleeping capacity. Decide what size home would best suit your group.
- There is a map in the back of the list so you can see where houses are located in comparison to conference center buildings.
- The key at the bottom of each page will help you see what sorts of amenities are available for each home. Washer/Dryer, AC/Heat, Dishwasher, etc.
- Contact the renters to find out more information on how to secure a housing rental.
- Now that you have a rental lined up, it's time to think about what you will need to do when you arrive in Montreat.
- All homes on the list come with pillows and blankets. Guests are encouraged to bring their own sheets and towels.
- All homes have kitchen facilities and cooking privileges. It is best to bring a few extra hands along to be in charge of preparing meals.
- Most homes have great gathering rooms which are a nice place to build group relationships and to use for activities such as devotions.
- It is important to make sure you do a general cleaning of your cottage before you leave and do your best to leave it like you found it.
