



MONTREAT MEMORIAL GARDEN PLAQUE OF REMEMBRANCE APPLICATION

A Plaque of Remembrance is a way to remember those persons interred elsewhere but who wish to be remembered in Montreat. The cast bronze plaque is inscribed with only the deceased's name, date of birth, and date of death of the person being remembered and attached on the columbarium wall in the Montreat Memorial Garden. Plaques of Remembrance will be placed on the columbarium wall in the order of receipt of payment and completion of the application, unless it is noted below to wait and place both plaques together.
