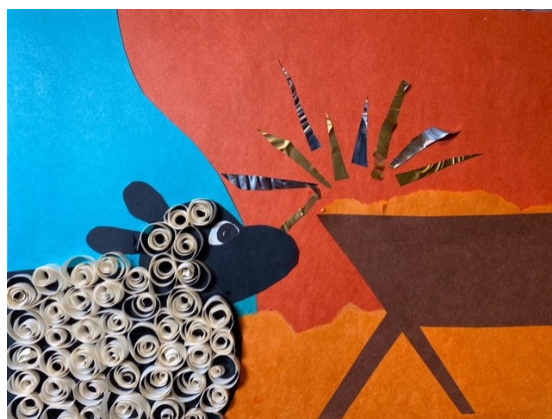

Quilling Lamb Craft - Older Artists

Supplies: Blue, black, white, gold, and orange construction paper, shiny gold wrapping paper, glue, scissors, and toothpicks.



Instructions:

1. Begin with a piece of orange construction paper as your canvas.
2. Add a shape cut from the blue paper along the side to represent Mary.
3. Tear some yellow paper and place it along the bottom of your canvas to represent the hay in the stable.
4. Cut out simple shapes for the lamb's body, head, and ears and glue these down.
5. Cut thin strips of white paper and wind them around a toothpick to create coils. This is an old method of art making called quilling. Dip one edge of these in a small puddle of glue and add them to your lamb to represent the wool.
6. Using brown paper, cut out simple shapes to make a manger. Tear more gold paper to create hay for the manger.
7. Use the gold wrapping paper to create light radiating from the Christ Child.
