## Lamb Craft - Younger Artists

Supplies: Blue, green, and black construction paper, white tempera paint, gold ink pen (or small gold star stickers), shiny gold wrapping paper, glue, and scissors.



Instructions:

1. Start with a full sheet of blue construction paper; this is your canvas.
2. Tear green paper to create the meadow and glue it to the bottom of your canvas.
3. Cut a large oval from the black construction paper to be the lamb's body, a smaller one to make the head, cut out four legs, an ear, and a small tail. Glue these to the construction paper in the shape of a lamb as shown above.
4. Using your thumb, dip into a small bit of paint and stamp your thumb over the lamb to make the "wool". On the face, place a small dot of black construction paper in the center of one of your paint dots to create the lamb's eye.
5. Cut a large star from the gold wrapping paper and place it in the sky. Using the gold marker (or your star stickers), dot and draw other stars in the sky.
