Plein Air Sketching Workshop Materials list:

- Watercolor block or watercolor field sketchbook: 5" x 8.5" or up to 12" x 16"/ such as Moleskine book bound watercolor sketchbook or fluid brand cold press watercolor blocks.
- Watercolors: Pan set of artist grade watercolors; at least 8 colors including yellow, blue, red and black or near black such as, *Cheap Joe's Voyager 12 color pan set*, or tube watercolors and a small portable palette.
- Brushes: several good quality round #2, 4, 6, 8 and one flat ½" such as Silver Black Velvet or Princeton Aqua elite.
- Pencil: mechanical #2 lead pencil or HB artist's pencil with small sharpener
- Pens: Sakura Pigma Micron pens or similar waterfast permanent liner pens in several tip sizes.
- Collapsible artist's cup or other cup for water
- Eraser: Cheap Joe's extra soft eraser (white) or similar or a kneaded eraser
- Small pack or tote to carry supplies around.

Optional:

- We will be using benches and available chairs at Montreat but if you have a favorite, easy to carry camp chair to bring, it may come in handy.
- An Umbrella that can be mounted on a chair or tripod also may come in handy if you find a view that you love that is not in the shade.

We will be outdoors so bring weather-appropriate clothing and supplies for comfort, such as a hat, insect repellent, sunscreen and a water bottle.
