



COFFEE FILTER ANGELS

“Then an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified.” -Luke 2:9

Since today’s scripture passage is about an angel delivering the news of Christ’s birth, we are going to make our own angels out of coffee filters! This craft is simple and friendly for all ages.

RECOMMENDED SUPPLIES

- 2 or more coffee filters
- Metallic pipe cleaner
- Popsicle stick
- Scissors
- Markers
- String
- Glue/Hot glue gun
- Sequins

CREATING YOUR ANGEL

1. Start by using a coffee filter to make your angel’s robe. First, fold the coffee filter in half, so that you have a half moon shape. Then, fold each side in toward the center, leaving enough room at the top to serve as a “neckline” for your popsicle stick.
2. Use your glue to affix the robe to the popsicle stick.
3. To make the wings, again fold a coffee filter in half. Gather the middle section together and twist a pipe cleaner around, cinching everything tight.
4. Glue your wings to the back of the popsicle stick, letting the robe slightly overlap the bottom of the wings.
5. Make a small halo from a pipe cleaner. Glue it to the back of the popsicle stick.
6. Use markers to give your angel a face. Feel free to decorate other sections of your angel at the same time!
7. Finally, use a little bit of glue to add some string to the back of your angel for hanging.
