



PINE CONE ORNAMENT

Today, we are going to make a special ornament inspired by nature! Start out by going for a walk and collecting any pine cones you see. We will use these as the base for our ornament.

As you walk, ponder today's scripture passage from Luke 2:14. "And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host, praising God."

RECOMMENDED SUPPLIES

- Pom poms
- Paintbrushes
- Small bowl or plate
- Scissors
- String
- Glue
- Hot glue gun (optional)

DECORATING THE ORNAMENT

1. Pour some glue into a small bowl or onto a plate. Anything that will allow you to easily dip a paint brush into the glue!
2. Use your paint brush to dab glue onto the tops of the pine cone scales.
3. Once the scales are covered in glue, add your pom poms. Push them gently onto the glue and hold in place for a few seconds to ensure that they stick well.
4. After adding all of your pom poms. Leave the pine cone to dry.
5. Once the glue is dry, cut a length of string and tie it around the top of your pine cone. Then, tie the ends together to create a loop.
6. Finally, hang up your ornament to display it proudly!
